

NORTHEASTERN WISCONSIN / CESA 8

The summer of 2011 began the introduction of REACH BC+ in Cooperative Educational Service Agency District 8 (CESA 8). The region CESA 8 serves is home to 27 school districts in seven counties, many of which are in rural communities. Two faculty members from UW Extension Family Living Programs in the area join CESA 8 administration and **covering kids & families** in the first stages of introducing the project to key school staff and administrators, planning local strategies to promote knowledge about BadgerCare+ and identifying opportunities for eligible children and families to enroll in BadgerCare+.
